Business:

- Update on Fiscal Year 2021 Budget
 - Southeast Vermont Transit updated the committee on the status of the Fiscal Year 2021 budget.
 - Currently E&D program is on schedule for FY '21 budget
 - Covid continues to impact service
 - Bellows Falls Senior Center briefly opened, but has subsequently reclosed.
 - Rockingham Meal Site has reopened
 - Small uptick in ridership since beginning of covid.
 - Wilmington site remains closed.
 - In-home delivery of meals continues.
 - Shopping trips continue to run.
 - Ridership is down.
 - Social Trips have been made available but no trips have been taken.
 - Riders have been made aware of social trips however potential riders belong to vulnerable populations, many are limited activities due to covid.
 - 41% of budget used overall.
 - On schedule.
- Medicaid Opening.
 - Medicaid trips will resume in early 2021.
 - Costs for rides will be shared between E&D program and Medicaid.
 - Cost per trip will go down.
 - No indication Adult Day Centers will reopen in near future.
 - Very late spring or early summer at the absolute earliest
 - Likely at extremely limited capacity.
 - o Large increase in ridership in Rockingham anticipated with reopening of Medicaid
 - SeVT is increasing staff and vehicles in preparation for increase.
 - Instituting new operating Medicaid compliant policies.
- Impact of Covid on ridership.
 - Ridership is down 40% from pre Covid numbers.
 - Most riders are severely limiting non-essential trips.
 - Ridership has remained consistent since beginning of Covid crisis.
 - ~300 trips per day in Rockingham.
- Updates from VTrans
 - Status of Vaccinations.
 - State is communicating with transit providers biweekly.
 - Currently transit workers in vaccination group 1B
 - o Expect vaccinations for workers to begin by June.
 - State and Transit providers are coordinating to ensure vaccine sites are located on transit routes.

- Cares program will provide direct funding for vaccination trips.
- State has received new round of Federal stimulus money.
 - Vermont received \$26.7 million for transit providers, E&D committee
 - FY '22
- Bylaws for Open Meeting Compliance.
 - o Committee moves to adopt new bylaws in compliance with Vermont Open Meeting Law
 - Motion by Randy Schoonmaker, Second by Christine Howe.
 - Motion passes unanimously.
- Workplan Draft
 - Draft of committee work plan to be completed by June 30th.
- Ridership survey follow up.
 - Committee will follow up with riders who expressed interest in last year's ridership survey
 - Phone Calls & Summary completed by June 30th
 - Draft of potential questions will be brought to next meeting February 26th.
