Question of influx of new residents and potential increase in demand for passenger rail service and intermodal connections. Increasing speeds to 79 mph (where feasible) is expensive but could have a large impact on ridership. Gap in advertising from Amtrak. Rail with trail opportunities?

Bikes on trains? (JR)


Potential future comments - COVID impacts and in-migration, rail with trail projects
