

# Tuesday, March 16th, 2024, 2:30pm:

- Severe winter storm coming up the coast shifts inland
- Suddenly aimed for Vermont
- Heavy, wet snow begins to fall overnight
- Little preparation has been done



# Wednesday, March 17th, 2024, 5:30am:

- Majority of southern region is without power
- Residents were largely unwarned
- Power, landline phones, internet, and cell service all impacted
- High impacts throughout state mean there is little information on when power might be restored

- What are your first steps?
- What locations have power and resources? Will you need to relocate anyone?
- What do residents need?
- How will you share public information?



### Saturday, March 20th, 2024, 9:00am:

- Total snowfall was nearly 30" in some areas
- Power has remained out in the southern counties
- Cell service is spotty and unreliable throughout smaller towns
- Shelters consistently have 7-15 people
- Regional shelter has opened in Bennington

- Have your essential function priorities changed?
- What vulnerable populations are at risk?
- How are you communicating with your team?
- How are you communicating with the public?
- Who is staffing shelters?







#### Tuesday, March 23rd, 2024, 9:00am:

- Power continues to be out in most towns in the southern counties
- Cell tower generators are running in central locations
- Shelters consistently have 5-10 people



### **Questions:**

- What state resources do you need at this point?
- How will you get them?
- How much fuel do your generators have?
- What will residents need?
- How are communications happening?
- What does recovery look like once power is restored?
